AIM OF CAMP

Visit to Parliament and local government, focus on democracy at work, discussions on international policy and sustainability, visit to Green industrial companies and forerunners in renewable energy, visit to significant architectural projects, you will experience the

Danish nature and visit top attractions such as Tivoli and LEGOLAND BILLUND.

Last but not least you'll go home with 19 new friends.

DEADLINE FOR APPLICATION

April 1st, 2020 – Participants will be accepted upon receipt and review of application.

CAMP FEE

DKK 1500 (Danish Crowns) equivalent to 200 Euro, payment details will be shared once your application is approved. Participants pay travel expenses to and from Copenhagen (CPH) themselves. We recommend bringing about DKK 1000-1500 in allowance.





HOW TO COME

Participants may **not** have participated in more than one Rotary camp prior, and **must** be sponsored by a Rotary club in their own country.

Health insurance, visa etc. are the entire responsibility of the participants.

ACCOMODATION

Participants stay together for all 14 days and are responsible for daily routines like shopping, cooking, dishwashing and keeping the place tidy.

You'll have plenty opportunities to develop relations and take responsibility.

The Camp is a scout's cottage like previous years. All participants will sleep in the same dormitory, and the accommodation is simple cottage style, however all appliances are available.

The Camp is located in Nærum, 20 kilometers north of Copenhagen with easy transport to the City.

TRANSPORT TO AND FROM COPENHAGEN

Nearest airport: CPH (Copenhagen Kastrup)
You organize and pay for your own travel arrangements to and from Copenhagen.

Rotary organizes pick up at the airport/central train station/central bus terminal and transfer to the Camp.

Please consider arrival and departure times preferably between 06 am and 10 pm.

You are welcome to contact camp manager for advice on travel arrangements.

During your stay, the following will be provided:
Accommodation, all food, local transport, entrance fees and free WiFi in camp.





WHAT TO BRING

Check the weather on www.yr.no before you pack.

Its summer in Denmark, average temperatures 18-21C. You may have rain, sun, wind ... Evenings may be chilly.

Bring a jacket, a light sweater, good walking shoes (no need for hiking boots), sandals or similar for the bathroom, swimsuit (optional, we go to the beach weather permitting), towel(s), your choice of personal necessities, etc.

You must bring your own sleeping bag (or similar). Bed and bedcovers are provided. A music instrument or other ways to entertain your group at the camp fire in the evenings is welcome.

One of the first days you will introduce yourself, your family, and our country. Bring whatever you feel could help you with the presentation: Photos on your computer/USB memory stick, your mascot...
