

DISTRICT GOVERNOR'S MONTHLY MESSAGE JULY 2020

Dear Rotarians, Rotaractors and Interactors in District 2482 – Bulgaria,

I share the joy of the coming of the **new Rotary year 2020-21**, in which we enter wiser because we have managed to rethink our optimism. Because we felt how much stronger **solidarity** makes us. And let us always have the motivation to prove that even without coercion mechanisms, as in business, we are able to organize **just as effectively** to achieve our Rotary goals!
